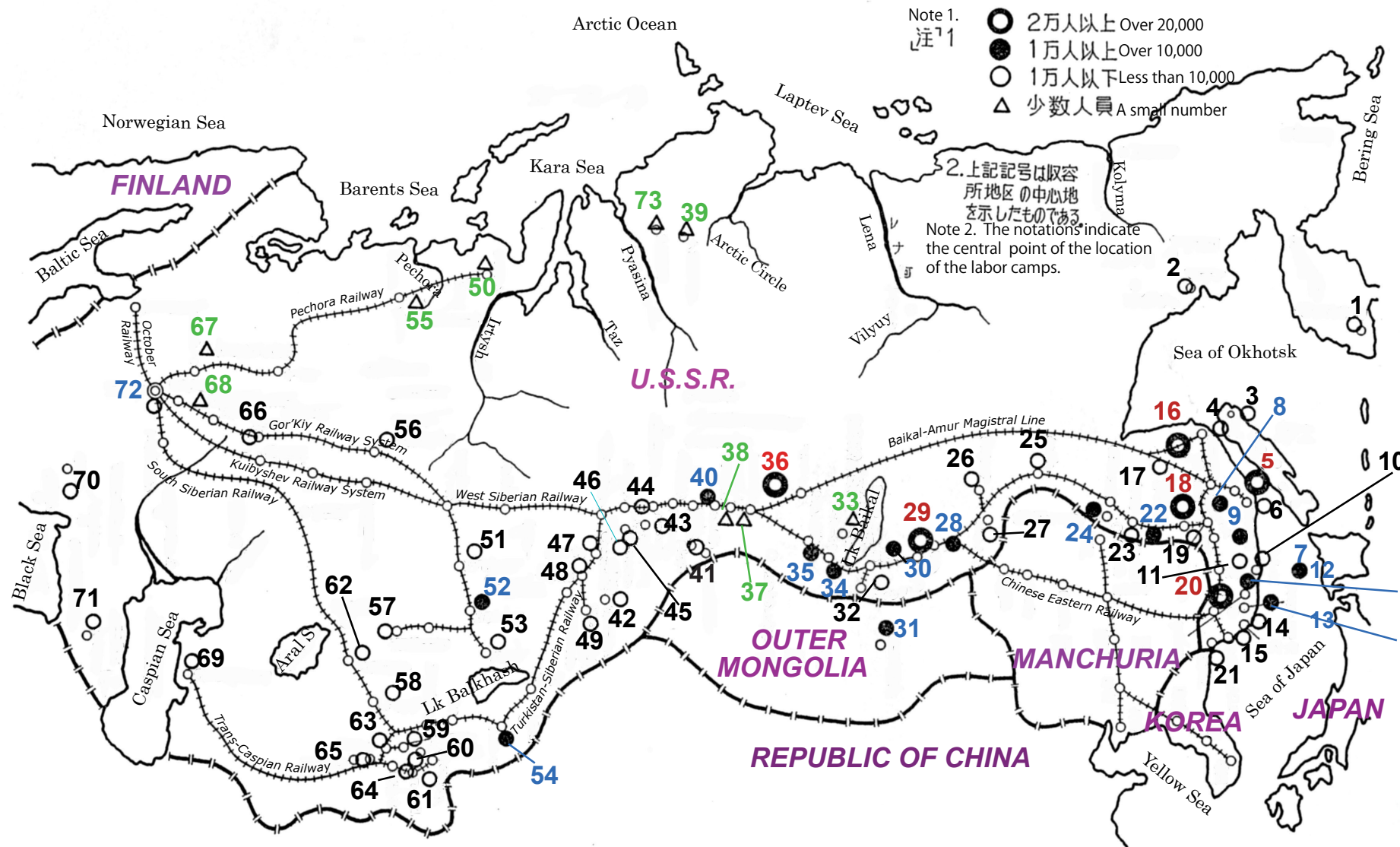


General Map of the Detained Japanese POW Labor Camps in the USSR and the Outer Mongolia around 1946
