



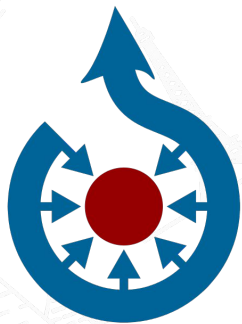

Español: Avenida del Bazaar en *Arg-e Bam*, o, Ciudadela de Bam, el mayor edificio de adobe del mundo y Patrimonio de la Humanidad según la UNESCO, situado en Bam, Provincia de Kermán, sureste de Irán. Los orígenes de esta enorme ciudadela en la Ruta de la Seda se remonta al imperio aqueménida (siglos VI-IV a.C.) e incluso antes. La ciudadela fue destruida por el devastador terremoto de Bam de 2003 que costó la vida a más de 26.000 personas y se encuentra en reconstrucción desde entonces.



English: Alley of the Bazaar in *Arg-e Bam*, or, Bam Citadel, the largest adobe building in the world and an UNESCO world heritage site, located in Bam, Kerman Province, southeastern Iran. The origin of this enormous citadel on the Silk Road can be traced back to the Achaemenid Empire (6th-4th centuries BC) and even beyond. The citadel was destroyed by the devastating 2003 Bam earthquake that cost over 26,000 lives and is being reconstructed since then.

Description **English:** This bunny shaped peson is a multiple of the weight of the seed of *Abrus precatorius* (0.14 to 0.19 g) which was used as reference for any weighing. Gold was extremely important in the economic and political life of the Akan kingdoms of southern Ghana and Côte d'Ivoire. Until the mid-nineteenth century, gold dust was the primary form of currency in the region. In order to measure precise amounts of gold, an elaborate system of weights, usually made of cast brass, developed by the seventeenth century. Beyond the usual function, the weigh of gold, often refer to political power, reproducing in miniature regalia, and some virtues such as wisdom proverbs generally comment. Today, the national currency has replaced the precious metal and the system weight is no longer relevant since the early twentieth century.

Welcome to the **GLAMwiki Toolset**. *Sharing just got a whole lot easier!*

The GLAMwiki toolset enables galleries, libraries, archives and museums (GLAMs) to easily make their digital content accessible to Wikipedia users and all of the world. The tool allows GLAMs to automatically upload large batches of digital versions of their content to [Wikimedia Commons](#), the online media repository of the Wikimedia movement.

Previously, it was difficult for GLAMs to upload their collections on Wikimedia Commons without direct help from an experienced Wikimedia collaborator. Now, with the GLAMwiki Toolset developed by [Europeana](#), GLAMs can directly upload curated batches of their content using the toolset. Anyone with basic knowledge of dealing with metadata can do the job. No additional technical knowledge is required.
